2. "Meetings attended as Non-Member" covers attendance of an elected member at meetings of Committees and Sub-Committees of which they are not a member. All Committees have specific members appointed.

3. In addition to attendance above, most elected members attended 14 other miscellaneous workshops where no meeting attendance records were taken.

4. To qualify for being in attendance at a meeting, an elected member must be present for at least 50% of the duration of the meeting. A meeting extending over two or more days counts as separate meetings. Separate Workshops and Briefings held on one day are counted as separate meetings.

5. No statistics were kept for members lateness, early departure.
