As one of the New Zealand athletes, Joseph faced a lengthy wait, approximately 50th in the queue, and when he finally began his first race, the area past the gate was extremely icy. Several competitors fell, but Joseph demonstrated resilience and finished his race. His second race was executed perfectly, showcasing his confidence on the slopes.



March 14,2025

Yesterday was an emotionally intense day for Joseph, who endured two falls during his first ski race. Despite the initial fall, he remained calm and reattached his ski. However, due to snow accumulation under his boot, it did not click into place properly, resulting in a second fall. Although he managed to retrieve his ski and complete the run, he was subsequently disgualified due to exceeding the time limit. His perseverance and determination to finish the race were truly commendable, and we all feel so extremely proud of him. As the adrenaline wore off, Joseph became aware of a painful sensation in his right knee, prompting his coach, Brian, to seek immediate medical attention. The doctor diagnosed the injury as a soft tissue bruise and recommended an ice pack to alleviate the discomfort. The medical staff's kindness and professionalism were impressive, despite the language barrier. Joseph's dedication to his teammates led him to watch their race, navigating the slope with difficulty due to his injury. Later, he received a participation award during the medal presentation ceremony. Today, Joseph's knee showed significant improvement, and he is expected to resume skiing tomorrow.
