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MEMORANDUM OF COUNSEL FOR THE REQUIRING AUTHORITY

MAY IT PLEASE THE COMMISSIONER:

[1] There has been a further development since our memorandum dated 1 May

2020.

[2] A Submitter in this proceeding, Aokautere Land Holdings Limited ("ALHL"), has

sought injunctive relief against the Council in the High Court, in order to

prevent any further processing of the Notice of Requirement to a hearing until

such time as its claim can be heard. The Requiring Authority intends to oppose

the application.

[3] The High Court has provisionally indicated a hearing date for the injunction of

20 May 2020. The Requiring Authority considers the appropriate course of

action would be to temporarily suspend the evidence exchange pending

completion of the injunction proceeding. A practical concern of the Requiring

Authority is that resourcing the preparation of evidence in accordance with

the indicated timetable will be considerably more difficult while also preparing

to respond to the injunction proceedings.

[4] Given that the application looks likely to be allocated a prompt hearing, the

Requiring Authority does not consider that a temporary suspension of the

timetable (nor commensurate delay in the NoR hearing) would cause

prejudice to any party involved in this process.

[5] Counsel can provide a further memorandum to update the Commissioner,

immediately following the High Court hearing on the injunction application.
