There are many wonderful parks and playgrounds in Palmerston North for children and families to use, including Celaeno Park which has large fields and a playground area. Celaeno Park is an excellent alternative for those living locally in Kelvin Grove, as are the local schools with fields and playgrounds.

It does not make sense to have such a huge area of Linklater made onleash. In the section where the agility course and aeroplane are, there is wide expanse of field and grassy area which I have never seen children use in all my times up there. Children and families tend to only walk the tracks to the aeroplane. Dogs however, make best use of this area running around and playing with other dogs.

If any area was to be made on-leash, I would suggest the first section at the entry of Linklater Reserve only, and it would make sense to move the aeroplane down to be included in this area, rather than moving the agility course out of its current location. The remaining area of playground behind the swing bridge, could remain off-leash so that the wetlands and fields can continue to be used by dogs freely, and if needed, the timber playground area could be fenced off. Prior to having a dog, we had children and accepted that Linklater is first and foremost a dog park. We would take our kids there and never had any issues with dogs. Dogs may have run up to us or close by but there were never any incidents. If we had a child who was extremely anxious around dogs, we would have appropriately not chosen to take them to that environment and chosen an alternative.

Linklater Reserve, as a dog park, is one of the biggest assets for Palmerston North. It is a wonderful place to go with dogs to allow them freedom to run around, socialise with other dogs, and provide physical and mental stimulation. We have a Cavoodle who absolutely loves his trips to Linklater. He enjoys running through the wetlands, racing through the large grass areas, using the agility course, and playing with other dogs. It is one of the only places this can be done safely. Along the river walkway, there is often a large volume of walking and cycling traffic (often people cycling at speed on e-bikes) and therefore having a dog off-leash is often not practical or appropriate. We accept this, and will choose when it is/is not appropriate to do so for everyone's safety. At Linklater, there are no concerns regarding walking or cycling traffic and dogs can run freely. We spent significant time and energy training our dog, who is now 2 years old. He has excellent recall, but it can be stressful keeping an eye on him at the river during times of high volume walking and cycling traffic in order to ensure he does not cross the path or cause an injury to someone who is cycling, for example. I strongly oppose the proposed changes to Linklater Reserve. If a compromise needs to be made, I would suggest move the aeroplane down the front and make the first section only on-leash. The rest of the areas should remain off-leash to allow for maximum use of the spaces. Children and families have many places they can run around and be free; dogs do not. Thank you.
