PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To provide information on trends in pool admissions and the cost of Programme 1611 – Free Swimming for Under 5 Year Olds in 2019/20 and the 2020/21 year to date.


2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The provision of free entry to Council owned pools for children under 5 years and their accompanying supervisor was trialled in 2019/2020 through the inclusion in the Annual Plan of Programme 1611 Free Swimming for Under 5 Year Olds.
- Following the early success of the trial, Council made a budget provision of \$147,000 in the 2020/21` Annual Plan to continue the programme.
- 2.3 Officers report admission figures and expenditure to Council via the quarterly report.
- 2.4 This memorandum provides information on monthly pool admissions for 2019/20 and 2021/22 (to the end of April 2021), and the forecast cost of the programme at year end.

3. RESULTS FOR 2019/2020

- 3.1 Pool Admissions:
 - 11,936 supervisors
 - 14,806 pre-schoolers







4. RESULTS FOR 2020/21- YEAR TO DATE

4.1 Pool Admissions:

- 14,333 supervisors
- 16,779 pre-schoolers



4.2 Cost of programme:

5. TRENDS

- 5.1 During the period 23rd March 2020 to 13th June 2020, Council pools were by closed by Level 3 and 4 COVID -19 restrictions. Figures for March June have been excluded from the figures for 2019/2020 and 2020/21, to enable a direct comparison between the two years to be made.
- 5.2 The total number of admissions from July through February 2020/21 was 9% higher than for the same period in 2019/20.
- 5.3 Pool entries for admissions between July-February follow the same pattern each year.
- 5.4 The Supervisor/Child ratio is similar in both years; 1:1.25 in 2019/20 and 1:1.17 in 2020/21.

6. FORECAST YEAR END POSITION

- Based on entry numbers to date, and an estimate of patronage for May and June 2021, Programme 1611 is forecast to cost an additional \$12,174 by year end.
- 6.2 This is within the remaining budget provision for the programme.
