## 1. ISSUE

1.1 In June 2022, Council passed the following resolution:

"That the Animal Shelter project be audited (from start to awarding the tender contract) and presented to the appropriate Committee."



1.2 This memorandum presents the outcome of the requested audit.

## 2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 On 1 October 2018 a new Code of Welfare (Code) amendment, "Temporary Housing for Companion Animals", came into effect. Following a review, it was noted that Council's existing facility was non-compliant with the new code.
- 2.2 In February 2020, four options were presented to Council to meet the compliance requirements. Council resolved to build a new facility.
- 2.3 In February 2021, two developed designs were presented to Council. One a base build and a second with the addition of an educational space. Council resolved to progress with a base build only. This required an increase to the initial budget approved.
- 2.4 In June 2022, a request was put forward to Council to increase the budget and also to award the construction contract to Lee Builders. These requests were approved by Council.
- 2.5 At this point, Council requested a review of the processes that were undertaken from the start of the project up until the tender was awarded. The outcome of this review is attached.
- 2.6 The facility is currently partway through construction with the intention to open early 2024.

## 3. NEXT STEPS

3.1 The recommendations are closely aligned with those that have been raised through other Business Assurance Reviews. These will be followed up through the 6 monthly accountability reporting.
