Te Rere Hau Windfarm Resource Consent Hearing

We act for Tararua Wind Power Limited (**TWPL**) who made a submission dated 1 June 2017 on the review of conditions of the resource consent for the windfarm known as Te Rere Hau and operated by New Zealand Windfarms Limited.

TWPL neither supports nor opposes the review, but rather has raised a concern that the review conditions may require it to turn off its windfarm to allow Te Rere Hau noise monitoring to occur.

New Zealand Windfarms Limited has sought to include an advice note below Condition 10.2 to clarify this is not the case, which TWPL supports (refer Statement of Evidence of Adrian Low dated 25 August 2017, paragraph 118 and attached conditions and Statement of Evidence of Stephen Chiles dated 25 August 2017, paragraphs 44 and 45).

The Joint Witness Statement on Planning Matters of Craig Auckram and Adrian Low dated 11 September 2017 records agreement between the expert planners on, inter alia, the proposed advice note.

On the basis that TWPL supports the inclusion of the agreed advice note it decided to not attend the hearing and, instead, we request that this letter of position be tabled with the hearing committee for consideration.
