**Submission of Lawrence John Hill
as to Conditions Proposed by Palmerston North City Council**

Dated 20 October 2017

1. I previously made a submission to the Palmerston North City Council's Hearing Panel (**the Panel**) on 2 June 2017 as to changes to the Consent Order (dated 30 May 2005 in Env W 0039/05 and 0041/05).
2. I then made a Supplementary Submission dated 8 September 2017 and spoke to that submission on 13 September 2017 to the Panel.
3. I have made a submission on the conditions proposed by New Zealand Windfarms Limited (**NZWF**) dated 13 October 2017 (**Submission 3**)

Proposed Conditions by NZ Windfarms.

4. I have reviewed the conditions proposed by the Council sent to me on 10 October 2017 at 8.51am (**proposed conditions**).
5. I am pleased that the Council considers continuous monitoring appropriate in its proposed conditions. However, I submit that the proposal of the Council is insufficient as to the data required to be supplied and stored. I refer to my Supplementary Submission at para 23 and the conditions I proposed specifically condition 7.2.
6. With the sole exception of the continuous monitoring, I despair that the concerns I provided to the Panel both in my written submissions, my oral submission, and my submission 3, appears to remain unconsidered. I restate that had my submissions been properly considered by them then, at the very least, the two typographical errors I had identified would have been corrected in both of their respective proposed conditions.
7. So, as it stands, those errors remain unchanged, and the submissions I have made appear to have gone unconsidered (with the exception of continuous monitoring).

Main Areas of Concern

8. With the exception of continuous monitoring now proposed by the Council, and as mentioned above at para 5, the main areas of concern I raised in my Submission 3 remain unchanged and I resubmit those to the Panel.
9. Again, I stand by the conditions I submitted the Panel in my Supplementary Submission.

Should the Panel seek anything further from me, I would be pleased to assist them.
