PURPOSE OF MINUTE

- 1 The purpose of this minute is to respond to a request by submitters Mr Clel Wallace and Ms Nicky Banks-Wallace to extend the timetabling directions issued by the Panel by minute dated 17 October 2017.

INFORMATION / DIRECTIONS

- 2 The Panel's minute dated 17 October 2017 required submitters to provide all parties with a response to the proposed conditions by 20 October 2017.
- 3 Submitters Mr Clel Wallace and Ms Nicky Banks-Wallace have requested that this deadline be extended until 27 October 2017 on the basis they delayed their submission due to advice received from the Applicant's representative that the timelines for submissions had been changed.
- 4 We are unsure as to the accuracy of this. However, the Applicant has confirmed approval for a short extension to be granted to allow any further submitter comments to be made on the proposed conditions.

Accordingly we direct:

- 5 Prior to **5pm 27 October 2017**, submitters are to provide all parties with any further response they have on the proposed conditions.
- 6 PNCC and NZ Windfarms are to provide a joint memorandum of counsel to all parties prior to **5pm 1 November 2017**, addressing the matters set out in paragraph 12 of the Panel's minute dated 21 September 2017.
- 7 Subject to the above timeframes being met and no unforeseen issues arising, the Hearing will formally be declared closed on **6 November 2017**.
- 8 Subject to paragraph 10, the Decision of the Panel will be issued on or before **27 November 2017**.
